PROGRAMMING

- This two-day program is highly interactive with each general session followed by a facilitated small group breakout session. The agenda is developed through discussions with trustees and CEOs
- Topics include governance best practices, enterprise risk, population health, and comparisons to other industries
- Fireside Chats guests include university presidents, Senators, non-health industry CEOs and trustees. The Academy research and deep-dive case studies are used as learning tools

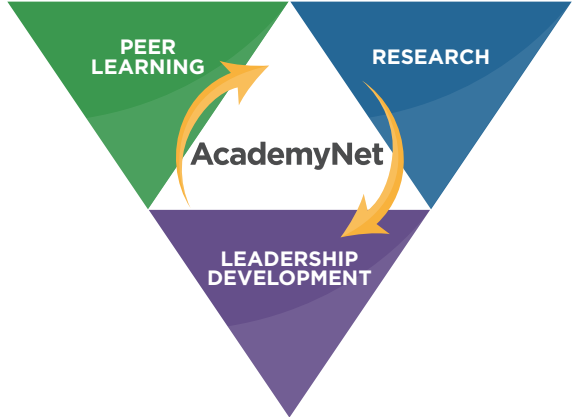

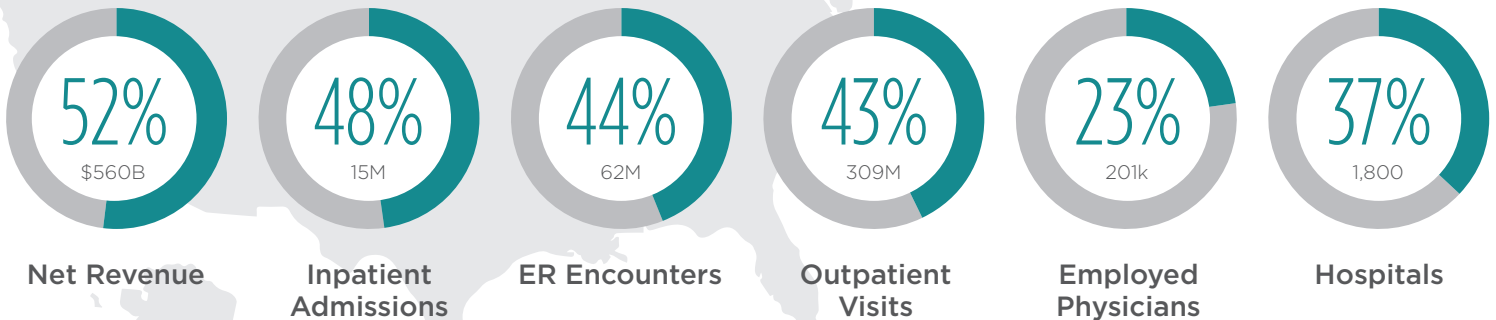
